

- Bike Right**
- Always ride on the right side of the road
 - Obey all traffic signs and traffic signals
 - Wear the right high visibility clothing
 - Wear the right safety gear – Always wear a helmet
 - Never wear headphones while riding a bike
 - Remember to signal when turning
 - Ride on roads with bike and pedestrian paths and lanes
 - Regularly check your bikes – Tire pressure and bike chain

Elkhart, Kosciusko, Marshall, and St. Joseph Counties

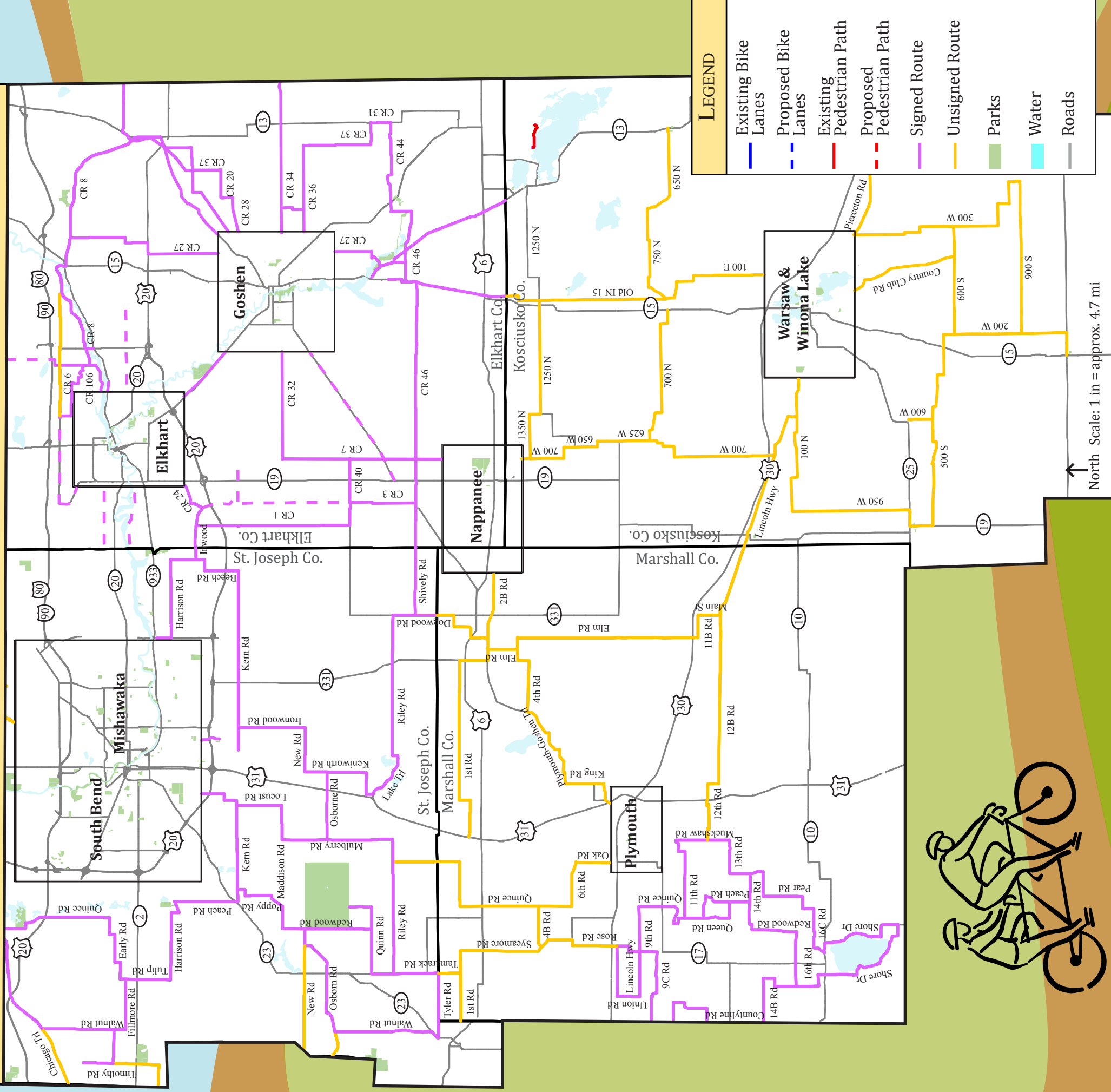

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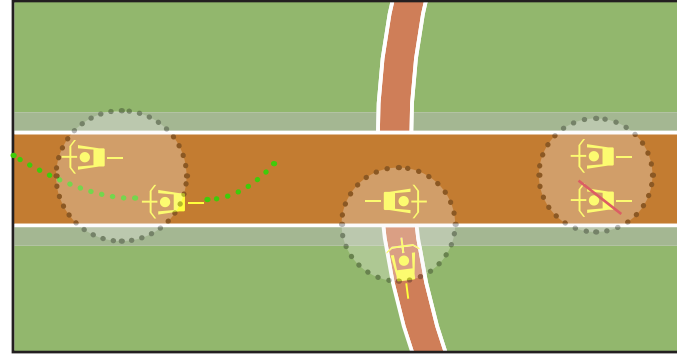
MICHIANA AREA REGIONAL BICYCLE MAP

Look both ways before proceeding.

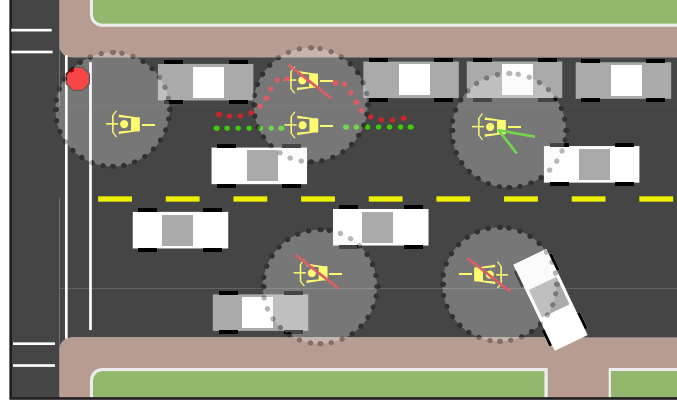
Pass on the Left

Warn others when passing

Keep to the Right

Avoid interfering with oncoming riders

Obey all Traffic Regulations

Ride predictably and follow the law

Ride in a Straight Line

Avoid weaving between parked cars

Scan the Road

Use a mirror to check traffic regularly.

Keep to the Right Side

Riding against traffic is dangerous and illegal

Be Aware at Intersections

Drivers may not see you approaching
