SFY 2019 Annual Listing of Obligated Projects

July 2018 - June 2019



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INTRODUCTION

The Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) is the regional planning agency responsible for transportation planning in Elkhart, Kosciusko, Marshall, and St. Joseph Counties in Indiana. MACOG is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for St. Joseph and Elkhart Counties, and as well serves as the Rural Planning Organization (RPO) for Kosciusko and Marshall Counties.

As the designated MPO for the region, Federal law requires MACOG to prepare a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to indicate how the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) will be implemented. The TIP identifies projects programmed regionally for federal funding under several programs including Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG), Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ), Federal Transit Administration Section 5307, 5309, 5310 and 5339 Programs, and other federal transportation programs.

MPOs are required under the authorized transportation bill, Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, to publish an annual listing of projects which funds have been obligated in the preceding year as a record of project delivery and progress report for public information and disclosure. An obligation is the Federal government's legal commitment to pay the Federal share of a project. Projects for which funds have been obligated are not necessarily initiated or completed in the program year, and the amount of the obligation will not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects, obligation occurs when the FTA grant is awarded. For Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) projects, obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the state or grantee requests that the funds be committed to a project.

In addressing FAST Act requirements, this report lists all transportation projects in the region that were obligated during state fiscal year 2019 (July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019). The Annual Listing of Obligated Projects is consistent with the project listing in the TIP. This includes project description, designation number, as well as the amount of funds programmed in the TIP and its funding source; see Appendix B for list of applicable funding sources.


SUMMARY OF OBLIGATED PROJECTS

Total Obligation

Projects are obligated by three sponsoring agencies in the MACOG Region: Local Public Agencies (LPAs), Transit, and the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT). Figure 1 shows the funding breakdown of all of the projects that were obligated by each agency in SFY 2019. The total obligation in the MACOG region was approximately \$53.1 million; State sponsored projects consisted of nearly \$28 million in obligations, locally sponsored projects reached \$22.3 million and transit projects obligated for just over \$2.7 million.

The remainder of this report will focus on the LPA sponsored projects showing breakdown by county and funding source. Additionally, profile sheets are included for each project, categorized by county, showing project location, type, and obligation amounts.

LPA OBLIGATED PROJECT SUMMARY

County Funding Breakdown

In SFY 2019, there were 44 projects sponsored by LPAs that saw obligations in the MACOG region for a total of \$22.3 million. These LPAs included the Cities of Elkhart, Goshen, Plymouth, South Bend, Mishawaka, Nappanee, and Warsaw; the towns of Culver, North Liberty and Winona Lake; the Counties of Elkhart, Kosciusko, Marshall, and St. Joseph. Figure 2 shows the total amount of funds that were obligated in each county. St. Joseph County had the highest amount of obligations of \$9.5 million, making up 42% of total funds. Elkhart County obligated \$8.6 million, adding 39%. Kosciusko and Marshall Counties came in with a combined total of \$4.2 million in obligated funds for the remaining 19% of the obligated funds.





Figure 3: Total Count of Local Public Agency Projects

Figure 3 shows the total number of projects obligated in each county. 15 projects were obligated in St. Joseph County, or 34% of the total number of projects. In Elkhart County 11 projects obligated, making up 25% of the total. Combined, Kosciusko and Marshall Counties had 18 projects obligate, which made up 41% of the total number of projects.

Figure 2: Total Local Public Agency Obligated Funds

Funding Type Breakdown

There were 9 funding sources used on obligated projects in SFY 2019, see Appendix B for description of each funding source. Figure 4 depicts the amount of federal funds obligated by funding type. The Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG) Groups I-IV had the most obligated at approximately \$15.4 million. Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) and Recreational Trails Program (RTP), combined with Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) followed with a total of \$5.6 million. Additionally, Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) and Bridge funding amounted to \$1.3 million.

Figure 4: Total LPA Obligations by Funding Type




Figure 5: Total LPA Count of Projects By Funding




Figure 5 shows the total number of obligated projects by each funding source. STBG Groups I – IV had the most projects obligate at 16 projects, which made up 36% of the total. The next highest was TAP/RTP with 13 projects, followed by bridge funding at 9 projects and CMAQ with 5 projects, which all amounted to 61% of the total local obligations. HSIP funding was placed on 1 project, a total of 2% of the total number of projects.

Project Type Breakdown

Projects can also be broken down into project type. There were 5 project types which obligated in SFY 2019; Local Road, Bike/Pedestrian Facilities, Bridge, Intersection and Safety; see Appendix A for more information on each project type.

Detailed maps are included for each project highlighting the project's DES number, location, sponsor, TIP programmed funding and obligation amounts. The areal imagery for the mapping was collected in calendar year 2019 and highlights many of the completed or under construction projects.





Figure 7: Total LPA Count of Project Types

Figure 6 shows the total amount of funds obligated in SFY 2019 for each project type and Figure 7 shows the total number of projects with funding obligated by each project type. Local Road projects had the most funding at \$13.7 million obligated, or 61% of the total project obligation. While Bike/Pedestrian Facility projects had the greatest number of projects with obligated funds at 18 projects.

The following pages are profiles of each LPA sponsored project that had funds obligated towards them in SFY 2019.

Figure 6: Total LPA Obligation by Project Type

Figure 8: Total Obligations by LPA Project Type





Figure 9: Total Number of LPA Projects by Type

Figure 10: Total Obligation by LPA Project Type





Figure 11: Total Number of LPA Projects by Type

Figure 12: Total Obligation by LPA Project Type





Figure 13: Total Number of LPA Projects by Type



Figure 15: Total Number of LPA Projects by Type





Appendix B: Funding sources referenced in the SFY 2019 Annual List of Obligated Projects.

Surface Transportation Block Group Program (STBG)

The Surface Transportation Block Group Program (STBG) is the primary funding source for transportation projects. It is separated into several categories: Group I, Group II, Group IV, and State.

Group I – This is designated for use for urbanized areas with populations of at least 200,000. In the Michiana region, it is available for the South Bend Urbanized Area.

Group II – This is designated for use for urbanized areas with populations greater than or equal to 50,000 but less than 200,000. In the Michiana region, it is available to the Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Area.

Group III – Is available for use in cities and towns greater or equal to 5,000 but less than 50,000. In the Michiana region, it is available to Nappanee, Plymouth, and Warsaw.

Group IV – is available for use in towns in rural areas that have populations under 5,000 and non-urbanized portions of counties.

Transportation Alternative Program (TAP)

Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) provides funding for programs and projects defined as transportation alternatives. TAP projects could include bicycle and pedestrian facilities, improving access to public transportation, community improvement activities, safe routes to school sidewalk projects, and projects for constructing roadways largely in the right-ofway of former Interstate System routes or other divided highways.

Recreational Trails Program (RTP)

The Recreational Trails Program is a matching assistance program that provides funding for the acquisition and/ or development of multi-use recreational trail projects. Both motorized and non-motorized projects may qualify for assistance. The funds are made available through a portion of revenue received by the Federal Highway Trust Fund from federal motor fuel excise tax paid by users of off-road recreational vehicles.

Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ)

Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) provides flexible funding for transportation projects. Funding is available to reduce congestion and improve air quality for areas that do not meet NAAQS for ozone, carbon monoxide, or particulate matter (non-attainment) as well as for areas that were once out of compliance but now meet the standard (maintenance).

Bridge Funds

Bridge funds are available to all counties for bridge rehabilitations, replacements, and systematic preventative maintenance. Local public agency (LPA) must be in compliance with National Bridge Inspection Standards. To be eligible for bridge funding, a bridge must meet four (4) criteria: 1) it must be on NBI database 2) sufficiency rating of 80 or less 3) classified as structurally deficient or functionally obsolete 4) cannot have been rehabilitated or reconstructed in the last ten (10) years. Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

The goal of the program is to achieve a significant reduction in traffic fatalities and injuries on all public roads. HSIP requires data driven and a strategic approach to improving road safety that focuses on performance.

Railway-Highway Crossing (Section 130) Program

The Section 130 program provides funds for the elimination of hazards at railway-highway crossings. The Program has been correlated with a significant decrease in fatalities at these crossings. This funding source began in 2014 and has seen a 57% reduction of fatalities at rail-highway crossings since that time. Money for Section 130 is set aside annually from the HSIP apportionment. In SFY 2019 \$240 million nationwide was set aside for these projects.
